



Free Smoke Detector Program

Who is eligible to receive a smoke detector and installation? What are the requirements?

- Residents must reside within Auburn City limits or Union Township
- Residents must own the residence (not rent) and are not a landlord using the detectors for rental properties.
- Residents requesting a smoke detector agree the Auburn Fire Department will install the detector(s) at a time agreed upon by both the fire department and the residents.
- The homeowner/individual 18 years or older must be present at the time of installation and agree to sign the liability release form.

Any resident needing a smoke detector and meets/agrees to these requirements, can call Fire Station 2 at 260-925-8255 or stop by at 902 S. Grandstaff Drive between 8:00am-4:00pm and set up an appointment.
